The National Seminar:-

Social change is defined as variation or modification in any aspect of social processes, patterns or forms. Change may be in the social structure, functioning social relationship, mobility of people in a society. Society has undergone rapid and radical changes due to advances in science and technology in recent years. Economic growth, the population explosion and wars have also contributed too many of the changes. Seen around us what has education to do with these changes? Two questions may be raised in this connection

(1) Was education a condition or an instrument by which these changes came about?

(2) Is education affected by these changes? In order to answer these questions it would be relevant to discuss what is meant by social change.

Social change is a continuous process, which may be very slow or rapid; the conscious efforts of some thinkers give if a jolt sometimes. Social changes implies changes in the social structure and function of the various units which form society for example , changes in the structure and function of the family , the school , the laws of marriage and inheritance labour regulations and others . Some thinkers identify social change with cultural change which is the narrow sense, refers to changes in customs, speech and literacy forms, language, dress, or hair styles. Changes in the structure of society take place at a much slower rate than changes in function. Cultural change is an important aspect of social change and occurs in a series or cycles, influenced by other forms of culture. Hence we may examine the relationship between education and social change.

Various attempts have been made by eminent thinkers during recent years to arrive at the meaning of the term ‘ education’ from various angles in which it is also important as stated that the education is a natural harmonious and progressive development of man’s innate powers.

In the wider sense, education means the process of development influenced by everything in life. In the narrow sense, it includes a few special influences having a bearing on the development of the child; these influences affect the child through a specialized agency called the school. Hence the education is needed for living a socially desirable life, for renewing and rebuilding the social fabric for helping the process of development and adjustment to the environment.
